Be sure to give us your personal number which is on your envelopes.

REFLECTION

Today is Pentecost Sunday which is reminding us that we received amazing gifts from the Holy Spirit on the day of our Baptism and our Confirmation. They are not material gifts, like toys, video games or kitchen appliances that you might get for your birthday. Those gifts just stay on the outside. They don't really sink into who you are.

Can you go to the store and buy a box of braveness? So that you can eat it and suddenly you become brave? Of course not! Can you go to the store and buy a box of wisdom? You eat a few bits of these and suddenly you become capable of judging things like a wise person? Of course not! Or imagine, you had a special cream in the pharmacy called piety; and it makes you feel truly reverent and easily able to pray to God the Father? Of course not!

Let us focus on the gifts of the Holy Spirit. It is these gifts that we want to look at today. What are they? Do you remember? The seven gifts of the Holy Spirit are: Wisdom, Understanding, Counsel, Fortitude, Knowledge, Piety and Fear of the Lord. Which one of these gifts did you receive from the Holy Spirit lately?

Here is my conclusion. Every day, you use these gifts from the Holy Spirit, whether you know it or not. It is like breathing. You are not conscious of it. But, you do it anyway.

On the day that you and I will end up face to face with Jesus, I hope that Christ will be able to say to each one of us: « Réjean, David, Lucy, Barbara, during your lifetime on earth, you had the eight gift of the Holy Spirit; guts! You became a real follower by saying yes to the Holy Spirit.

Completion of the month of prayer to the Blessed Virgin Mary

Let us conclude this marvellous month of May consecrated to the prayer to Mary, with this reflection from Pope Benedict XVI for the feast of the Visitation of the Blessed Virgin and the memory of the Immaculate Heart of Mary, on May 31 2008.

"The Rosary, when it is not a mechanical, traditional form of repetition, is a Biblical meditation that allows us to trace the events of the Lord's life in the company of the Blessed Virgin, pondering them, like her, in our heart. In many Christian communities during the month of May there is the beautiful custom of reciting the Holy Rosary in a more solemn way in families and in parishes. Now, that the month is ending, may this good habit continue. Rather, may it continue with more commitment so that, at the school of Mary, the lamp of faith may shine ever more in the hearts and homes of Christians.

Dear brothers and sisters, let us return home with the *Magnificat* in our heart. Let us bring the same sentiments of praise and thanksgiving of Mary to the Lord, her faith and her hope, her docile abandonment in the hands of Divine Providence.
