


### The Church and Office are Open!

- During the weekend, you can attend one Mass only. We want to be able to offer Mass to as many people as possible every weekend.

- **In order to attend any weekend Mass you must be registered.**
- Also, the government is asking you to wear a mask during the entire Mass. You can only remove your mask to receive Holy Communion. They want to prevent a third wave because of the variant.
