

**Most Holy Trinity, May 30<sup>th</sup> 2021**

In today's Gospel, Jesus commissions his disciples to baptize in the name of the Trinity; this is one of the clearest attestations for Baptism in the name of the Holy Trinity found in Scripture. For this final mission, the eleven are told to go to all nations. Also, as we read this Gospel on the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, we are reminded that this central mystery of faith is meant to be lived. As baptized Christians, we share in the life of the blessed Trinity and seek to invite others to share in God's love.

### **New rules for Covid 19 from the Government**

- Beginning May 31st, we are now allowed to have Mass with more people. The number of persons allowed in the church will still have to follow strict social distancing. Consequently, there will not be a big increase for the attendance at the church. If you would like to attend any weekday Mass, you don't need to register. However, in order to attend Mass on Saturday or Sunday, you must be registered.
  - During the weekend, you can attend one Mass only. We want to be able to offer Mass to as many people as possible every weekend.

  - In order to attend any weekend Mass you must be registered.
  - Also, the government **is still asking you to wear a mask** during the entire Mass. You can only remove your mask to receive Holy Communion.

### **Make disciples from all nations. Baptize them in the Name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit»**

Today, our liturgy invites us to worship the Holy Trinity, our God, who is Father, Son and Holy Spirit. One only God in three Persons, in whose name we have been baptized. Through the grace of the Baptism we are called down here to participate in the life of the Holy Trinity, in the darkness of faith, and, later on, after death, in eternity. Through the Sacrament of Baptism we are made to share the divine life, getting to be sons of God Father, brothers of Christ and the temple of the Holy Spirit. With the Baptism our Christian life has begun by receiving the vocation of sanctity. Baptism makes us people who belong to Him, He who excels as the Holy one, the «three times Holy» (cf. Is 6:3).

The gift of sanctity we have been granted through the Baptism requires faithfulness for a task of evangelic conversion which must always guide the life of God's children: «This is the will of God, your holiness: that you refrain from immorality» (1Thess 4:3). This is a compromise affecting all those that have been baptized. «All the faithful of Christ of whatever rank or status are called to the fullness of the Christian life and to the perfection of charity» (Vatican II Council, Lumen gentium, 40).

If our Baptism was the true entrance to God's sanctity, we could not satisfy ourselves with a mediocre, routine and superficial Christian life. We are called to perfection in our love, inasmuch the Baptism has introduced us in the life and intimacy of God's love.

With deep gratitude for the benevolent design of our God, who has called us to participate in his live of love, let us today and always worship and praise him. «Blessed be God the Father and his Only-begotten Son and the Holy Spirit: for he has shown that he loves us.
