

Fourth Sunday of Easter, May 8th, 2022

Today's Gospel speaks powerfully about the familiarity and intimacy between Jesus and his disciples, expressed as recognizing and knowing another's voice. Today's Gospel also speaks to the relationship between Jesus and the Father. In the Gospel of John, Jesus identifies so closely with the Father that he tells us that they are one—not just close, but actually one. To know Jesus is to know the Father. Jesus doesn't just bring us closer to the Father, Jesus puts us directly into contact with God the Father, removing all distance between us. Our relationship with Jesus is an invitation to share in the life of God.



Jesus said: "My sheep hear my voice. I know them, and they follow me. I give them eternal life, and they will never perish. No one will snatch them out of my hand. What my Father has given me is greater than all else, and no one can snatch it out of Father's hand." (John 10. 27-30)

Visit of the Major Reliquary of Saint Brother André to Quebec City

The veneration of relics is quite ancient. It is in this spirit that the Major Reliquary of Saint André was created following his canonization. It is a means whereby Christian communities can receive this object of piety and invite their parishioners to offer prayers of veneration in its presence. The artifact is made up of various materials, and features a glass vial containing a few fragments of his heart. It will visit the Oratoire Saint-Joseph of Québec on Wednesday, May 11, 2022. Here is the schedule (celebrations in French):

2:30 Display of the Reliquary, 3:00 Adoration, 3:30 Special Mass and 4:15 Veneration of the reliquary.

"My sheep hear my voice and I know them; they follow me."

Today, Jesus' gaze over manhood is that of the Good Shepherd who accepts under his responsibility the sheep that are given to him by the Father and takes good care of each one of them. Between him and them He creates a link, a recognition, and a sense of loyalty: "My sheep hear my voice and I know them; they follow me." (Jn 10:27). The Good Shepherd's voice is always an invitation to follow him, to enter his magnetic circle of influence.

Christ won our hearts not only through his examples and his doctrine, but also with the awful price He had to pay of his Divine Blood. He suffered tremendously for all of us, and therefore, He does not want to lose any one of us. And yet, the evidence is clear: some do follow the Good Shepherd's call while others, do not. Some react with anger at the announcement of the Gospel while others jump with joy at the news. What do the latter have that the former do not? Saint Augustine, before the vast mystery of the divine election, used to answer: "God does not leave you, if you do not leave him;" He will not forsake you if you do not forsake him. Do not therefore put the blame on God, or the Church or on others, because you are the only one to blame for, the lack of your faithfulness being only yours. God does not deny anyone His grace, and this is precisely our strength: strongly stick to God's grace. It is no merit of ours; we have simply been "blessed."

Faith enters us through the ears, by listening to the Word of the Lord, so the greatest risk we run is our own deafness to the Good Shepherd's voice, because our head is full of noise and other dissonant voices. Or even worse, what in Saint Ignatious' Spiritual Exercises is called "to turn a deaf ear." That is, to know God is calling you to pretend not to hear it. He who consciously and repeatedly closes his ears to God's call is no longer in tune with Jesus and will also lose the joy of being a Christian by grazing in other pastures that neither satiate nor give eternal life. Nonetheless, only the Lord could have said: "I give them eternal life." (Jn 10:28).
