
Today's parable is a lesson in persistence in prayer. While the parable seems to present prayer as nagging God for what we want, such a reading misses the point. God is not like the judge in the parable, worn down by requests and coerced to respond. The key is found in the description of the judge as corrupt and unjust. Since God can be neither, we must understand Jesus to be saying that if even an unjust judge responds to the persistence of the widow, how much more so will God listen to our prayers. God truly wants to hear our needs and respond generously. He wants us to be persistent like the widow, staying in relationship with Him, confident that He hears and answers our prayers.



And the Lord said, "Listen to what the unjust judge says. Will not God grand justice to his chosen ones who cry to him day and night? Will he delay long in helping them? I tell you, God will quickly grant justice to them. And yet, when the Son of Man comes, will he find faith on earth?" (Luke 18.1-8)

"Pray always without becoming weary."

Today, Jesus reminds us about the necessity "to pray always without becoming weary" (Lk 18:1). He teaches with his deeds and with his words. St. Luke appears before us as the evangelist of Jesus' prayers. Quite so! In some of the scenes, where the authors inspired in the Holy Scriptures depict Jesus' life, only Luke presents him in the act of praying.

The Lord is a model of the petition prayer. He is a model during Jesus' Baptism in the river Jordan; when choosing the Twelve and at the Transfiguration; when a disciple asks him "Lord, teach us to pray" (Lk 11:1), and from his lips comes out the Lord's Prayer; when He announces his negations to Peter: "I have prayed that your own faith may not fail" (Lk 22:32); at the crucifixion: "Then Jesus said, 'Father, forgive them, they know not what they do" (Lk 23:34), and; when He dies: "Father, into your hands I commend my spirit" (Lk 23:46).

—I could point out how I will raise my heart towards God while doing different activities, because it is not the same intellectual work as manual labor; to be in a church rather than in a sports field or at home; to drive in the city or in a turnpike; it is not the same our petition prayer if it is for gratitude; adoration than pleading forgiveness; early in the morning, late, or after a whole day's work. St. Josemaría Escrivá gives us a recipe for the petition prayer: "More is achieved by whoever goes up closer to plead… That is why you must get close to God and be intent on becoming a saint."

The Virgin Mary is a model of prayer, particularly the petition prayer. At Cana of Galilee, she was able to advance Jesus' timing, the time of the miracles, with her petition, which was full of love for the newlyweds and full of trust in her Son.
