



Fifth Sunday of Easter, May 7th, 2023

The connection between Jesus and his Father, between Jesus' work and the work of the Father, is made clear in today's Gospel. Jesus is in the Father, and God the Father is in Jesus. As God spoke his name to Moses, "I am," so too Jesus speaks his name to his disciples: "I am the way and the truth and the life."

The revelation of the Trinity is completed in the passage that follows today's reading and it is the

passage that follows today's reading, and it is the Gospel for next Sunday. Because Jesus goes away, the Father will send in Jesus' name the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, who will continue the work of the Father and of Jesus.. (Loyola Press)

"I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me"

Today, the scene we contemplate in the Gospel puts us before the intimacy that exists between Jesus Christ and the Father; but not only that; it also invites us to discover the relationship between Jesus and his disciples. " And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come back again and take you to myself, so that where I am you also may be " (Jn 14:3): these words of Jesus not only place the disciples in a perspective of the future, but also invite them to remain faithful to the course they had undertaken. To share with the Lord the glorious life, they must also share the same path that leads Jesus Christ to the Father's dwellings.

"Master, we do not know where you are going; how can we know the way?" (Jn 14:5). Jesus says to him, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me. If you know me, then you will also know my Father. From now on you do know him and have seen him" (Jn 14:6-7). Jesus does not propose a simple way, certainly; but he marks the path for us. Moreover, He himself becomes the Way to the Father; He himself, with his resurrection, becomes the Walker to guide us; He himself, with the gift of the Holy Spirit, encourages and strengthens us so that we do not falter on the pilgrimage: "Do not let your hearts be troubled" (Jn 14:1).

In this invitation that Jesus makes to us, to go to the Father through Him, with Him, and in Him, His most intimate desire and His deepest mission are revealed: "He who for our sake became like us in order to make us his brothers, now presents to his true Father his own humanity in order to draw all his kindred up after him "
