


Mission Statement

"Do not be afraid of those who kill the body."

Today, after choosing the twelve, Jesus sends them to preach and instructs them. He warns them about the persecution they may likely suffer and advises them on their attitude: "Do not be afraid of those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul; rather, be afraid of the one who can destroy both soul and body in Gehenna" (Mt 10,28). The narrative of this Sunday develops the theme of persecution of Christ in a style reminiscent of the last Beatitude of the Sermon on the Mount (cf. Mt 5,11).

Jesus' speech is paradoxical: on the one hand, he says "Do not be afraid" twice, and he presents us with a providential Father who cares even for small birds; but on the other hand, he does not tell us that this Father will save us from troubles, rather the opposite: if we are his followers, we are likely to share his fate and that of the other prophets. So, how can we understand this? God's protection is his ability to give life to our person (our soul), and to provide happiness even in tribulations and persecutions. He is the one who can give us the joy of His Kingdom that stems from a profound life we can already enjoy here, and he is our guarantee of eternal life: "Everyone who acknowledges me before others, I will acknowledge before my heavenly Father." (Mt 10,32).

Trusting that God will be with us in difficult times gives us courage to proclaim Jesus' words in the light (cf Mt 10:27), and it gives us the energy capable of doing good, so that through our works people can give glory to our heavenly Father. Saint Anselm teaches us: "Do everything for God and for that happy and eternal life our Saviour deigns to grant us in Heaven."

Prayer to Saint John the Baptist

O God, You raised up St. John the Baptist to prepare a perfect person for Christ.

We call upon St. John's intercession to properly prepare us with a true sense of repentance to receive Your grace and salvation.

Make us faithful to Truth and justice, as You did Your servant,

John the Baptist, herald of Your Son's birth and death. Lord, may You increase Your life within us. Amen.
