

In today's Gospel reading, Jesus preaches the Kingdom of God. Like John the Baptist, Jesus' pronouncement of the kingdom is a call to repentance. Yet Jesus' preaching is greater than John's. Jesus begins the time of fulfillment; the Kingdom of God is already here. This will be demonstrated again and again, both in Jesus' words and in the actions that follow. Jesus' healings and forgiveness of sins are signs of the Kingdom of God that he announces in his teaching. The Kingdom of God is here and now. How might our lives be different if we more fully shared this sense of the immediacy of God's kingdom? (Loyola Press)


