

Earlier in the Gospel, we heard of Mary Magdalene and other individuals witnessing the resurrected Lord. Yet the response to them is the same— those whom they told do not believe them. Finally, Jesus appears to the eleven disciples and tells them to refrain from their disbelief. He then commissions them to be his witnesses in the world. He tells them to preach the good news, baptize others, and bring the good news to every corner of the world. In this reading, the same commission has been extended to people of all times and places. It is only after this final commission that Jesus ascends to the Father. (Loyola Press)


Information about registering for the Provincial Convention May 31-June 2 to be held at St. Thomas à Becket Church in Pierrefonds is available. We can carpool together!

Today, on the solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord, we are offered a Word of Salvation unlike any we could have imagined. The Lord Jesus has not only risen, defeating death and sin, but has also been taken up into the glory of God! Thus, the path back to the Father, the path we had lost and that was opened to us in the mystery of Christmas, has been irrevocably offered to us today, after Christ fully gave Himself to the Father on the Cross.

Offered? Yes, offered. For the Lord Jesus Christ, before being taken up to Heaven, sent His beloved disciples, the Apostles, to invite all men to believe in Him, to reach where He is. "Go into the whole world and proclaim the gospel to every creature. Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved; whoever does not believe will be condemned." (Mk 16:15-16).

This salvation that is given to us ultimately consists of living the very life of God, as the Gospel according to Saint John tells us: "Now this is eternal life, that they should know you, the only true God, and the one whom you sent, Jesus Christ." (Jn 17:3).

But what is given out of love must be accepted in love to be received as a gift. Jesus Christ, whom we have never seen, wants us to offer Him our love through our faith, which we receive by listening to the word of His ministers, whom we can indeed see and listen to. "We believe in Jesus whom we have not seen: they announced Him, that saw, that handled, that heard the word out of His own mouth... And faithful is He that promised; He deceives not you: only do not faint, but wait for the promise... Keep the faith, and He keeps His promise" (Saint Augustine). If faith is an offering of love to Jesus Christ, preserving and growing it increases charity within us. Let us, therefore, offer our faith to the Lord!
